

Scope of Service Guidelines | Emergency

- On camera assessment and evaluation of patient for presenting symptomology, safety, and severity of
 patient illness using evidence-based assessment tools such as the PHQ9 and the Columbia Suicide Severity
 Rating Scale
- Determine the condition of the patient chemical abuse, depression, anxiety, suicidal ideation, etc.
- Collaborative call with the local provider and eCare's psychiatrist, MSW and/or nurse to discuss recommended level of care, medications, and disposition planning
- Patient education such as verbal safety plan and means restriction for patients that will be discharged from the emergency department
- · Assistance locating an admitting facility if no beds are available at the local facility
- Provider-to-provider consultation for other behavioral health related needs
- No age exclusions for patients in the Emergency Department
