Common Procedures	- KOH Prep - Skin Shave Biopsy	
Consult Time	- Initial consults are 60 Minutes - Follow-up consults are 30 Minutes	
Peripherals Needed	- Dermascope, as applicable. - Pigmented lesion concerns require use of the Dermascope lens - General Exam Lens
