### Crisis Care: How it Works

- Law Enforcement receives a call that an individual is experiencing a mental health crisis.
- Law Enforcement responds to the individual.
- Law Enforcement introduces the individual to crisis care tablet or requests a text be sent by the Avel team to any personal device.
- Avel expert performs an assessment an makes a recommendation to Law Enforcement.
- Once encounter is complete, individual is provided community health resources for follow-up support.

## Caring for Law Enforcement

- When most people are asked to name the symptoms of depression, most people will answer "Sadness". However, did you know, there are many other symptoms of depression?
- Symptoms may include:
  - Lack of interest in activities
  - o Trouble sleeping or oversleeping
  - o Feelings of guilt
  - Psychomotor changes
  - o Difficulty thinking clearly or concentrating
  - o Fatigue or decreased energy
  - Changes in appetite or weight changes
  - o Irritability
  - Sadness
