Common Lab Tests and Diagnostic Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Basic Metabolic Panel (BMP)</li> <li>• Cholesterol Levels</li> <li>• Complete Blood count (CBC)</li> <li>• Complete Metabolic Panel (CMP)</li> <li>• Creatinine Kinase MB (CK-MB)</li> <li>• Partial Thromboplastin Time (PTT)</li> <li>• Protime (PT/INR)</li> <li>• Triglycerides</li> <li>• Troponin</li> </ul>
Common Procedures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2D-Echocardiogram</li> <li>• Ankle Brachial Index</li> <li>• Electrocardiogram</li> <li>• Exercise Treadmill Stress Test</li> <li>• Holter Cardiac Monitor</li> <li>• Nuclear Stress Test</li> <li>• Routine Angiogram</li> <li>• Stress Echocardiogram</li> </ul>
