Specialty care of Internal Medicine conditions include, but are not limited to, the following.

<p>Common Conditions and Diagnoses Treated</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cardiovascular Disease, including: Angina, CAD, Atrial Fibrillation, CHF, HTN, CVA, PAD, Dizziness, Syncope</li> <li>• Endocrine Disease, including: Diabetes, Thyroid Disease, Osteoporosis, Vitamin D Deficiency, Hypercalcemia</li> <li>• Gastrointestinal Disease, including: GERD, PUD, NASH, Diarrhea</li> <li>• Infectious Disease, including: UTI, Bronchitis, Pneumonia, Cellulitis, STD</li> <li>• Lung Disease, including: Asthma and COPD</li> <li>• Mental Health, including: Depression and Anxiety</li> <li>• Metabolic Disease, including: Hyperlipidemia, Obesity Diabetes, Gout</li> <li>• Musculoskeletal Disorders, including: Osteoarthritis, Inflammatory Arthritis, Muscle Strain, Rotator Cuff, Fibromyalgia</li> <li>• Patients with complex medical conditions including multiple co-morbidities</li> <li>• Preventative Care, including: Cancer Screening, Immunizations, Lipid Management</li> <li>• Women’s Health, including: Menopause, Birth Control, Dysfunctional Uterine Bleeding</li> <li>• Work up Anemia</li> </ul>
<p>Common Medications Prescribed</p>	<p>Provider will work within formulary to prescribe:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Anti-hypertensives</li> <li>• Antibiotics</li> <li>• GI Drugs, including: H2 Blockers, PPI, Anti-Nausea Medications, Motility Agents, Stool Softeners</li> <li>• Lipid Lowering Agents</li> <li>• Non-narcotic Pain Management, including: NSAID, Muscle Relaxants, Lidocaine Patch, Acetaminophen, etc.</li> <li>• Pulmonary Medications, including: Inhalers, Singular, Steroids (as needed)</li> <li>• Replacements, including: Iron, B12, Vitamin D, Calcium</li> </ul>
